<b>Restricted Reporting</b>	<b>Unrestricted Reporting</b>	<b>Limited Reporting</b>
<p><i>A Restricted Report is confidential reporting without triggering an official investigation but still allows the victim to receive medical treatment, SAFE exam, Line of Duty (LOD), advocacy services, and counseling. In order to elect the restricted reporting option National Guard members can <u>only</u> report the incident to the following personnel: JFHQ Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC), Wing SARC, Unit Victim Advocate (VA), Chaplain or health care provider.</i></p>	<p><i>Unrestricted reporting allows a service member who is sexually assaulted to obtain the following services: medical treatment, SAFE exam, Line of Duty (LOD), counseling, legal representation and victim advocacy services. Details regarding the incident will be limited to only those personnel who have a legitimate need to know. All sexual assault cases are automatically filed as an unrestricted case if the assault is reported to anyone <u>OTHER THAN</u>: JFHQ Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC), Wing SARC, Unit Victim Advocate (VA), Chaplain or health care provider.</i></p>	<p><i>A Limited Report allows a member who was NOT in a duty status to file a report without triggering an official investigation but still allows the victim to receive medical treatment, SAFE exam, advocacy services, and counseling. In order to elect the limited reporting option, National Guard members can <u>only</u> report the incident to the following personnel: JFHQ Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC), Wing SARC, Unit Victim Advocate (VA), Chaplain or health care provider.</i></p>
