ASSISTANCE

To determine if and how much assistance can be provided, the board reviews the following criteria:

**Payments are subject to availability of funds and approval of CCRF Board.*

**Nature of assistnace requested.*

**Degree of financial hardship.*

Examples of acceptable reasons for assistance (these do not necessarily justify funding, but are reasons depedning on overall situation): food, rent, utilities, medical services, medical perscriptions, insurance or vehicle payments, child care, personal needs when military pay is delayed or stolen, emergency home repairs (habitability/essential areas, but not home improvements), etc., as well as other emergency needs at the discretion of the approval authority.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any Soldier or Airman experiencing financial hardships as a result of casualties received during a deployment, official active duty or inactive duty for training while currently serving in the Tennessee National Guard; to include families of Guard members as defined in the CCRF Standard Operating Procedures.

LIMITS

No cash will be given directly to members or families.

Actual amount of award will be determined upon interview with the Guard member / family.

Means of disbursement of funds will be determined to best meets the needs of the Guard member / families.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The Combat Casualty Relief Fund (CCRF) provides assistance to qualified Soldiers and Airmen and members of their families. The fund has been established to offset financial hardships incurred as a result of injuries or combat related casualties obtained while serving on official active duty, inactive duty for training while currently serving in the Tennessee National Guard.

All requests will be submitted directly to the CCRF Board, comprised of Tennessee Air and Army National Guard members, as well as National Guard Association members. They will interview applicants and review requests to determine the amount to award. Actual amounts awarded will be determined on a case by case basis. The means of disbursement of the funds will then be determined what best meets the needs of the Guard member and families.
