NASHVILLE, Tenn. - Walton Andrew Moore, Jr. was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel in a recent ceremony at National Guard Headquarters in Nashville. Moore, a native of Dyersburg, Tenn., serves as the Antiterrorism/Force Protection Officer for Joint Force Headquarters, Tennessee National Guard.

Moore was pinned by Tennessee's Adjutant General, Major General Max Haston on March 26th, 2014. In attendance for the ceremony were from Newbern, Tenn., Moore's mother & father, Walton and Charlotte Moore; and his sister & brother in law, Pam and Danny Echols. He also works closely with command security officers, the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency, and civilian and military law enforcement personnel.
